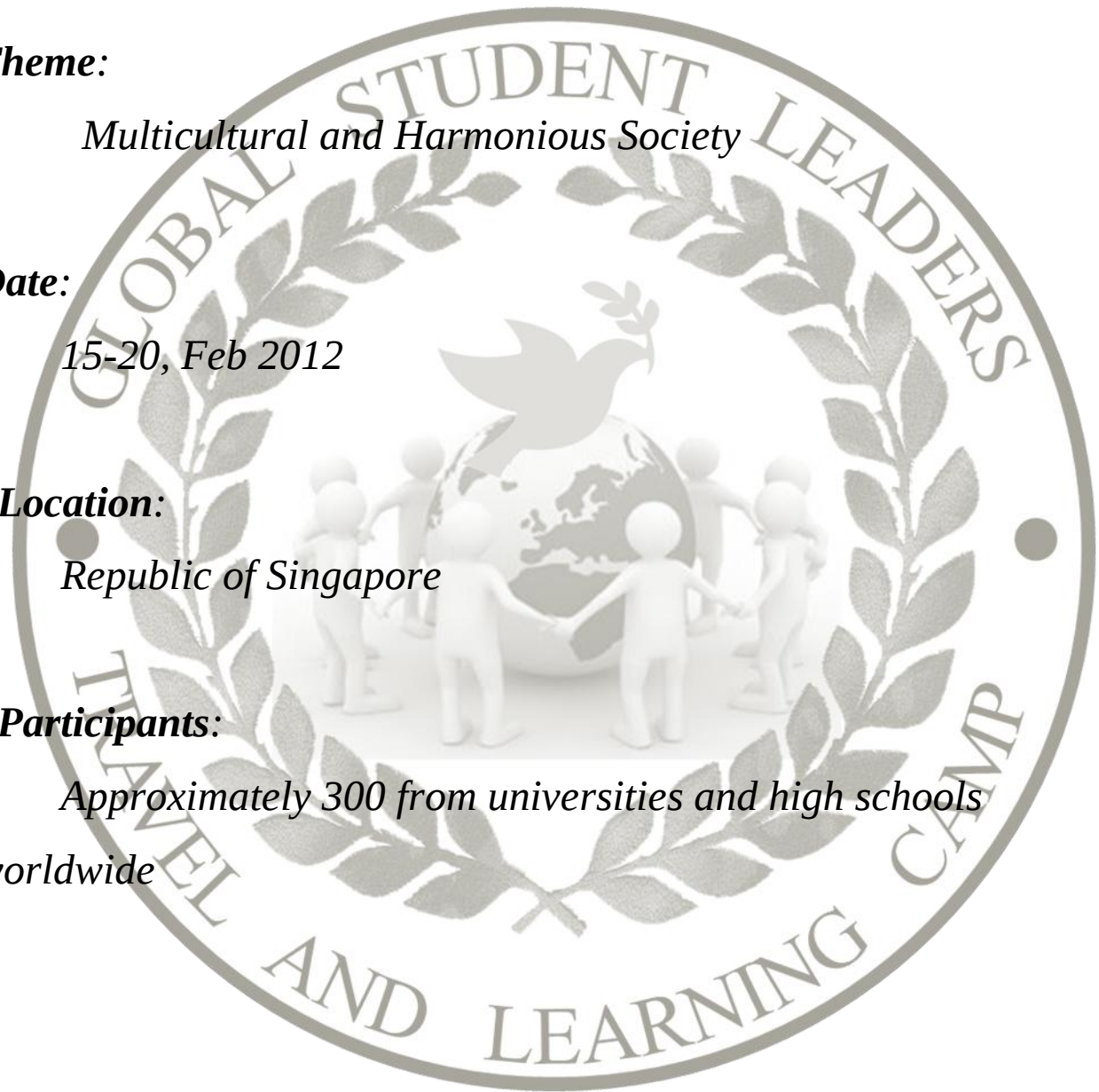

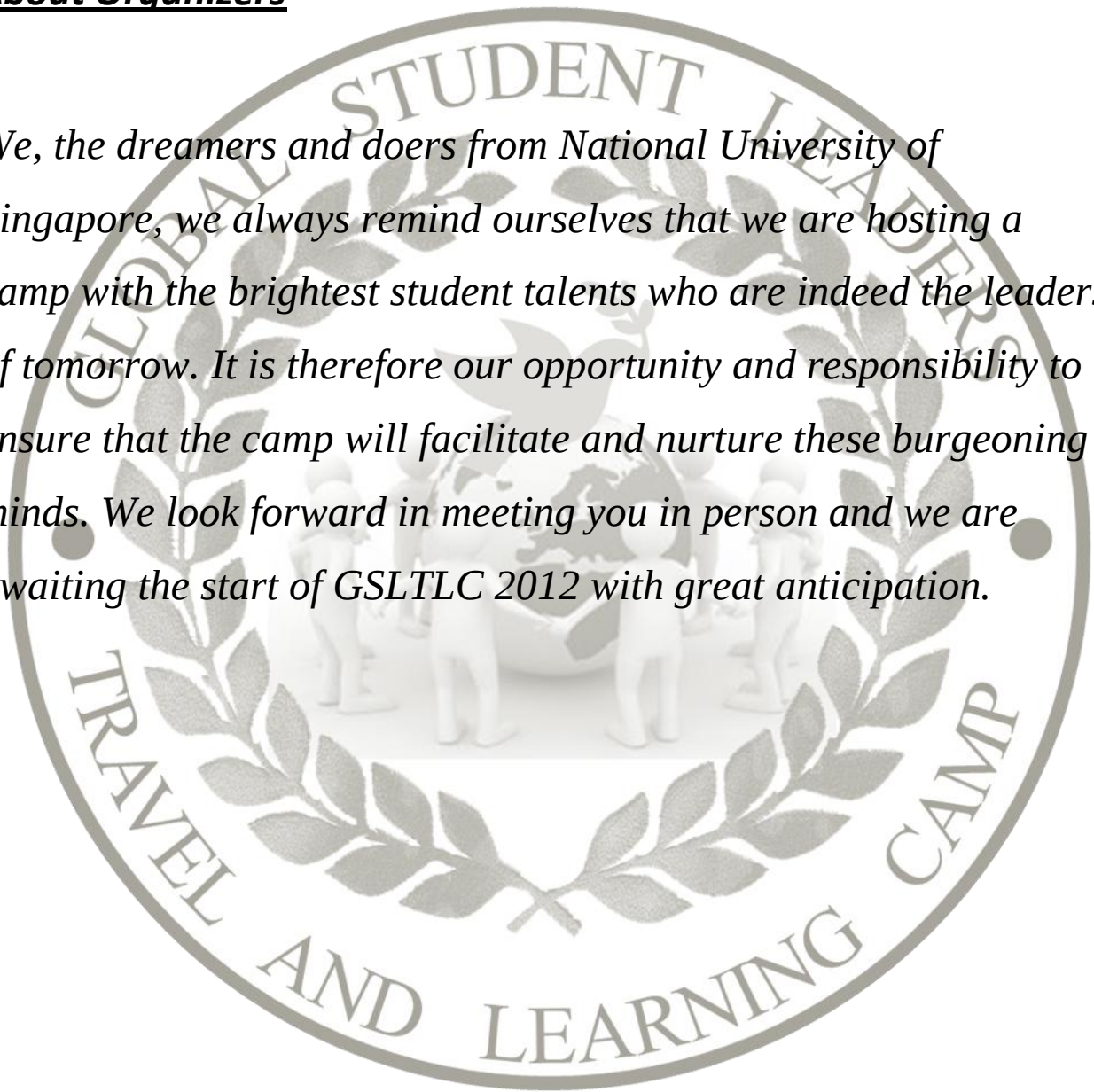

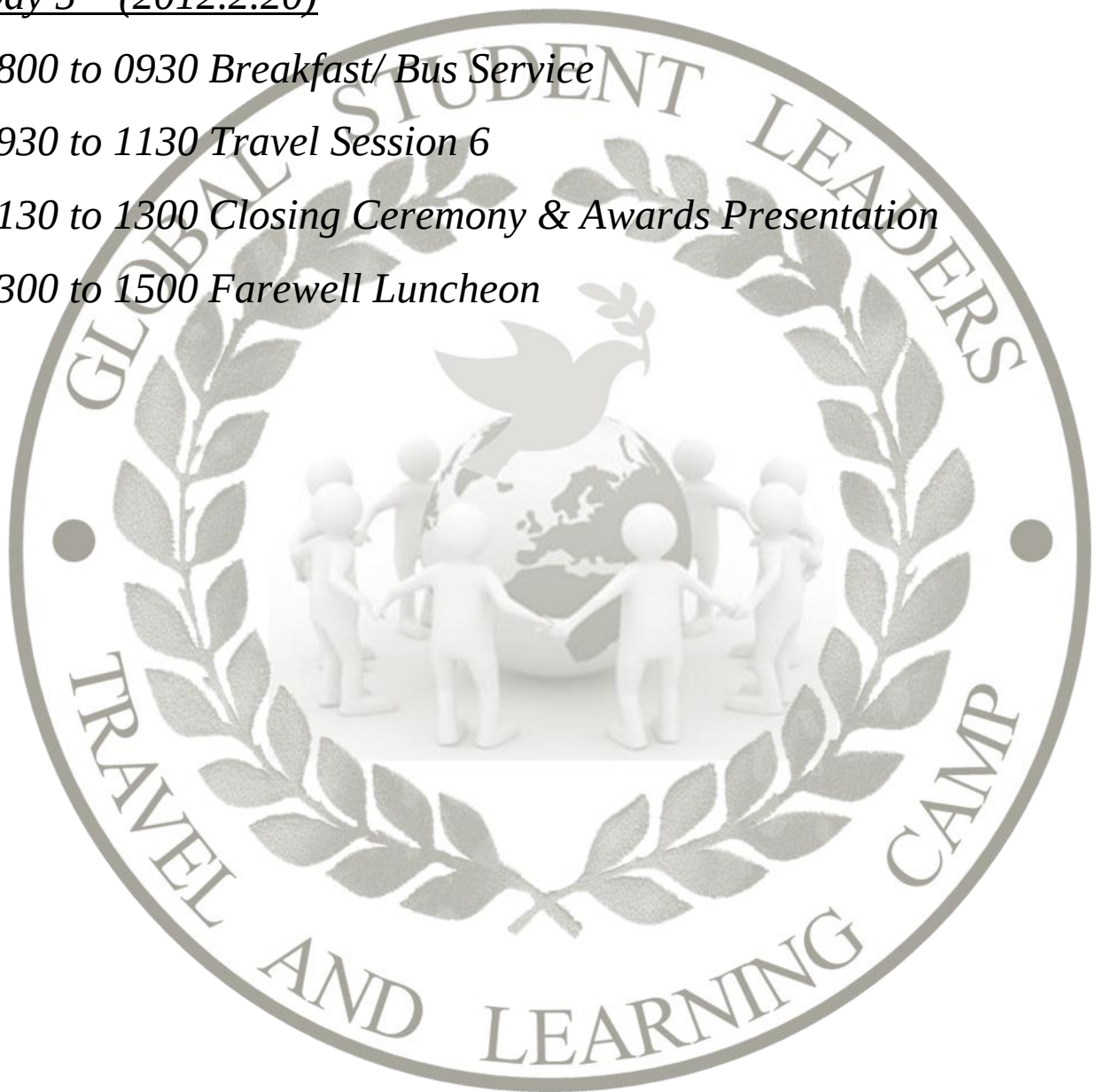

Structure of Sessions

The fundamental aim of our camp is to provide students an opportunity to gain a brand new learning experience through travelling and academic learning. Our programmes are designed in such a way that participants will be able to apply academic theories learned in learning sessions to explain phenomena and discoveries in travel sessions. Similarly, we believe only through authentic travel experiences participants will be able to link real life cases with their knowledge and thus, appreciate things they learnt in class. In order to understand Singapore society holistically, we will be examining four key areas that construct Singapore into a multicultural society and harmonious nation. The four areas/topics of travel and learning sessions are:

- 1.) Nature
- 2.) Culture & History
- 3.) Science & Technology
- 4.) Education

There will be in total six travel sessions and six learning sessions, all of them are dedicated to the theme and the topics so that participants will not travel blindly but with learning tasks in mind. The five days travel and learning experience aims to help participants to get first hands learning experience in depth, participants are free to choose the area/topic according to their interests. This is to say, participant who chooses the topic 'Education' for instance, will only be participating in the sessions on 'Education'.

After five travel sessions, participants are given a task to demonstrate their take away to other participants in the form of a group presentation. Presentation topics are closely linked to the four areas/topics. Participants are encouraged to critically apply their own knowledge as well as theories taught in learning sessions in their presentation.

Instructions for GSLTLC 2012 Application

Thank you for your interest in the Global Student Leaders Travel and Learning Camp (GSLTLC) 2012!

The GSLTLC organizing committee is inviting student leaders to apply positions as participants to GSLTLC 2012. Applications are on an individual basis with the eligibility criteria outlined below.

The following are eligible to be a GSLTLC participant:

- *Student leaders who are at least 16 but not older than 24 of age at the time of GSLTLC 2012. (To those student leaders who are under 21, an indemnity form which is available at Download page is required.)*
- *Student leaders who are curious, aspirant and outgoing.*
- *Student leaders who love travelling and learning.*

Applicants should also have following skills and experience:

- *Applicants should be fluent in English which is the working language of GLTLC 2012.*
- *Applicants should have the ability to communicate clearly and express thoughts and ideas.*
- *Applicants should have a basic knowledge of the theme of the camp.*
- *Applicants should experience in working effectively in a team environment.*

We would like to provide a world-class event to participants, so that we will be charging fees to support this meaningful and wonderful camp.

- Registration fee: SGD80 per participant (non-refundable)

Registration Fee:

A registration fee of SGD80 is due with the initial application for the camp. Both payments by major credit cards through Paypal or bank transfer are accepted. The organizing committee will only process your application after receiving the registration fee.

Participant fee & Accommodation fee:

A fee of SGD120 will be charged as participant fee and SGD620 as accommodation fee. Both payments by major credit cards through Paypal or bank transfer are accepted. Participant should only pay their participant fee and accommodation fee after receiving the Letter of Acceptance.

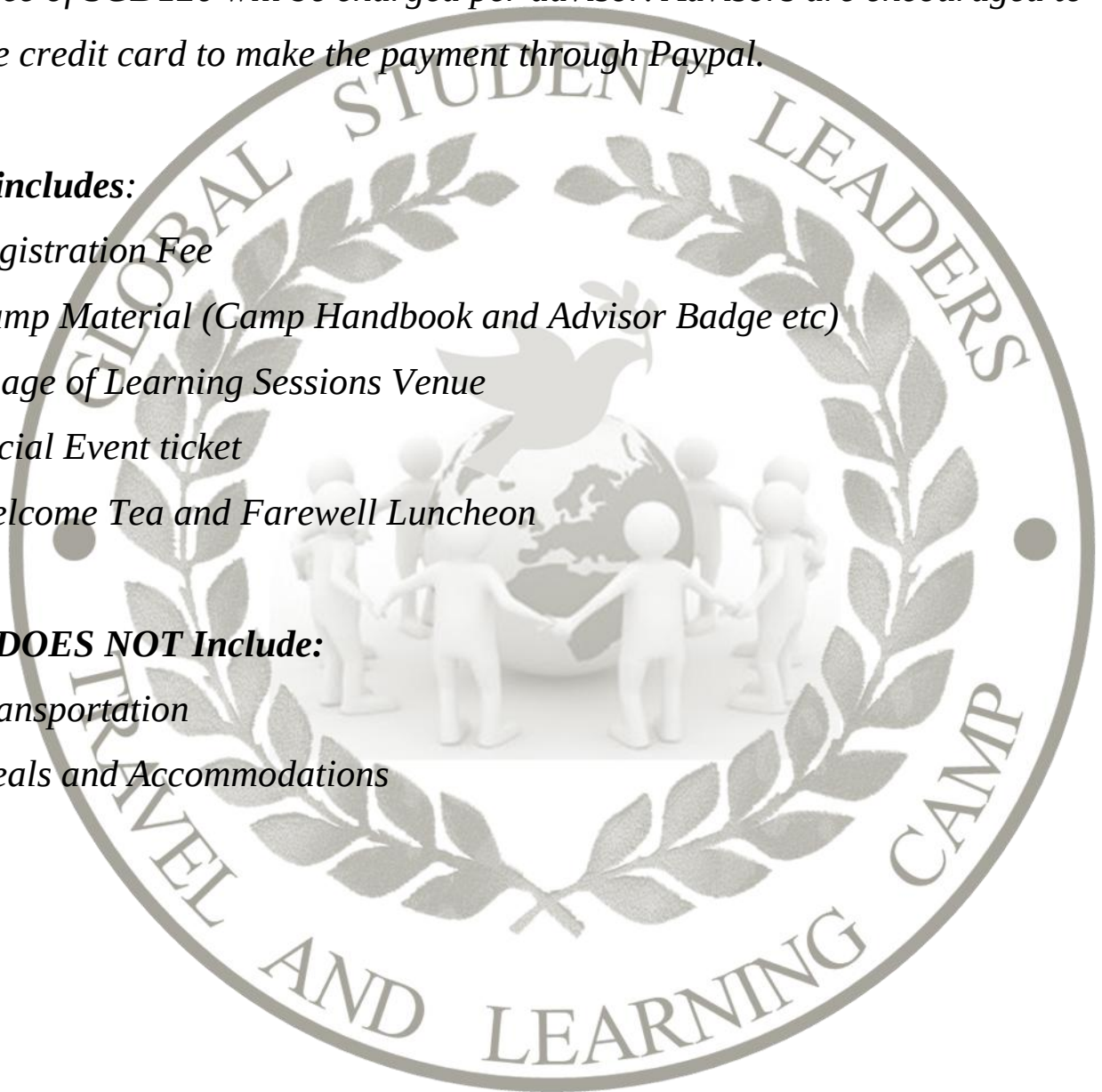
